Dues Associated with the SMS Band Program and Booster Club

- Mr. Adams' Band dues go to the Band Account at South, not the Booster Club. These dues pay for the annual band t-shirt, dry cleaning at the end of the season, some of our social activities (think snacks!), and contribute to the annual expenses of the program including supplies, registration fees, and sheet music.
